Aims and Objectives

Our policy on school uniform is based on the notion that school uniform:

- promotes a sense of pride in the School;
- engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the school;
- is practical and smart;
- identifies children with the school;
- prevents children from coming to school in fashion clothes that could be distracting in class;
- makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance;
- is regarded as suitable wear for school and good value for money by most parents;
- is designed with health and safety in mind.

PE Kit

For hygiene reasons all children must change for PE and Games Lessons

FOOTWEAR

Shoes should be comfortable and safe. It is dangerous for pupils to wear high heels, Open toes, platforms, or strappy sandals. Pupils should come to school wearing black shoes Or black trainers. Pupils can wear ankle boots in school, but they must change into sandshoes If the boots are higher than the ankle.

Jewellery

On health and safety grounds pupils should not wear jewellery to school. The only exceptions To the rules are as follows:

- a wrist watch may be worn;
- earrings are not encouraged but a plain stud in each ear may be worn; Pupils Must be able to remove their own earrings as they are not allowed to be worn for PE. In the case that earrings cannot be removed they should be covered with tape.

Nail Varnish, tattoos and make-up

The wearing of nail varnish, tattoos and make-up is not permitted.

Hair and hair accessories

Long hair should be tied back and styling should be standard. Hair Accessories such as Slides, bobbles, ribbons etc. these should be simple.

The role of Parents

We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform code. It is the responsibility of the parents to send their child to school in the correct uniform, that is clean and in good repair.

If a parent would like the school to modify the uniform policy (e.g. for Religious or Health reasons) they should make representation, in first instance, to the Head Teacher.

If have any issues with the school uniform guidelines, they should speak to their child`s class teacher in the first instance.

The role of staff

The class teacher will speak to pupils who do not wear the correct uniform.
